The Fuel cells and Hydrogen Joint Undertaking (FCH JU) is very pleased to invite you to its annual 2016 **Programme Review Days (21-22 November)** and to the **9th edition of the Stakeholder Forum (23 November)**, which will take place in the Charlemagne Building in Brussels.

The first two days will be dedicated to the FCH JU sixth edition of the Programme Review Days where the FCH JU programme's progress will be assessed notably in relation to the targets of its multi-annual and annual plans.
