REGISTERING YOUR ORGANISATION

DON'T

FORGET!

WHY REGISTER?

If you want to participate in a project proposal, your organisation needs to be registered and have a 9-digit Participant Identification Code (PIC).

HOW?

Via the Participant Portal: To register, you need to **login** in the Portal or, if you are a new user, <u>create your account</u>.

WHAT NEXT?

Perform the Financial Viability Self-Check!

The FCH 2 JU always checks the financial capacity of a project coordinator when the requested EU funding for the action is equal or superior to EUR 500,000





3.2 PART B of your PROPOSAL THIRD PARTIES

The beneficiaries must have the appropriate resources to implement the action

If it is necessary to implement the action, they may however:

- Purchase goods, works and services best value for money basis
- Use <u>Subcontracting</u> to implement action tasks best value for money basis
- Call upon "linked Third Parties" to implement action tasks
- Use in-kind contributions (resources) provided by third parties against payment or free of charge

3.2 PART B of your PROPOSAL THIRD PARTIES

Question:

In applying to Horizon 2020 calls, do all third parties need to explicitly appear in proposals?

ANSWER: yes

In the proposal, the planned involvement of all third parties must be described in the technical annex ("Description of Action" - Part B). The costs from the Part B need to be consistent with the costs you insert in the budget table.

3.3 PART B of your PROPOSAL ETHICS

Background:

"A proposal which contravenes ethical principles or any applicable legislation [...] may be excluded from the evaluation, selection and award procedures at any time." Art. 13 – H2020 RfP

Ethics Self-Assessment:

- All proposals must describe ethical issues raised & how they will be addressed
- Where: Part B Section 5
- Each applicant is responsible for:
 - identifying any potential ethical issues
 - handling ethical aspects of their proposal
 - detailing how they plan to address them in detail

How to complete your ethics self-assessment guide

Think of:

- Personal data

- Third countries

- Environment &

Health and Safety

- Dual use

3.4 PART B of your PROPOSAL IPRs & Exploitation and dissemination

Same principles as in FP7

for: ownership, protection, exploitation & dissemination

But consider in your proposal:

- Open access to publications
- Obligation to provide open access to scientific publication
- Open research data
- Access rights
 - Access rights of <u>affiliates</u>

For *background* (art. 25.4) and for *results* (art. 31.4) Under 'fair and reasonable conditions'

Access rights of the <u>EU institutions</u>

- For results (art. 31.5)
- For developing or implementing EU policies/programmes
- Royalty-free, non exclusive, limited to non-commercial / non-competitive use

Additional exploitation/dissemination obligations (as a <u>separate</u> document; requested by the FCH 2 JU AWP 2017; template available)
