NOTE TO THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE FCH JU

Subject: Negotiation results - Selection decision for Call FCH-JU-2012-1

The fifth Call for Proposals (FCH-JU-2012-1) of the Fuel Cell and Hydrogen Joint Undertaking (FCH JU) was published in the Official Journal of the European Union on 17 January 2012¹ and closed on 24 May 2012.

The indicative budget for the Call is 77,500,000 € to which will be added the EFTA contributions and the reactivated appropriations for an amount of 2,289,344 €. The total budget is 79,789,344 € as presented to the Governing Board on 11 October 2012.

The Council Regulation (EC) 521/2008² provides in its Article 5.2 (n) of its statutes that the Governing Board is "to approve the list of project proposals selected for funding".

On 11 October 2012 you approved the list of proposals with which negotiations were to open and the reserve lists for each application area. The negotiations for the 27 proposals in the main list and 1 proposal from the reserve lists started on 17 October 2012.

The negotiations on the **third batch** of the projects were finalised on 18 April 2013 (6 projects). This third batch of projects and the results of their negotiations are presented in the Annex hereunder.

Following Article 6.5 (h) of the statutes of the Regulation (EC) 521/2008, I hereby submit for the approval of the Governing Board the list of Grant Agreements to be concluded and kindly ask for your approval within the given deadline for response
