- > Preparation via a DG REGIO-supported pilot action
- Selected under <u>I3/Interregional Innovation Investments</u> (DG REGIO/EISMEA)
- Povide advisory and financial support to a consortium of innovation actors to bring their joint innovations to a mature level, ready for commercialisation and scale-up
- > 70% cofinancing rate
- > 70% of project budget should benefit to companies (mainly SMEs)
- Budget: 14 million € (10 million € EU support)
- Objectives:
- Develop joint innovation projects to boost production, transport and use of renewable H2
- Support practice exchange between its partners
- Expertise transfer and knowledge building more widely

THE EUROPEAN HYDROGEN VALLEYS S3 PARTNERSHIP

Great achievements in 4 years

- Largest network of European regions on H2related issues (from 4 to 60 regions)
- Promotion of the concept of H2 Valleys: from isolated projects to a dedicated EU roadmap
- Facilitate exchange of practices and projects set-up/Hy2Market/ GreenSkills4H2
- Regions now recognized as key players of the H2 value-chain
- Strong involvement in the European H2 ecosystem (close links with Clean Hydrogen JU and Hydrogen Europe)
- Involvement of regions in the Clean Hydrogen Alliance
- BUT the journey is not over
- Growing number of H2/Valleys in the EU (REPowerEU)
- Growing needs in terms of connection between these valleys and dissemination of practices
- Further support is key to ensure proper links between European H2 ecosystems
