# WHY

- The Joint Undertaking is a Public/Private partnership, so the cost of the programme are shared by public/private parties.
- An autonomous Programme-office, with 20 people staff and a separate office was established to run the grant-programme.
- The costs should be funded by the Community, industry and other public and private legal entities participating in the activities
- Private sector participants are partly organised in the NEW-IG and N.ERGHY; partly independent
- The running cost are funded by membership fees of NEW-IG and N.ERGHY and by the project-contribution from beneficiaries

To share these costs equally between the beneficiaries of the call the project-contribution was introduced



# **WHO**

- For a consortium to be eligible for the call, at least one legal entity must be a member of NEW-IG or N.ERGHY
- In general, the coordinator of a call has to be a member of N.ERGHY or NEW-IG
- All beneficiaries of a call of the FCH JU both members and non-members of NEW-IG/ N.ERGHY – are obliged to contribute an amount equal to 4% of the sum granted
- Proposal to improve the funding-rates released by EC on 20 April
- No 'free ride'



# Schematic overview collection process





## **HOW**

- Basis is contractual structure and bylaws
- Standard clause in the consortium-agreement to commit consortium-partners
- Coordinator of the consortium to collect all contributions and to transfer the full amount on behalf of the consortium
- Standard practice: Coordinator sets of the payment of the 4% against the out-payment of the pre-payment of the grant.
- Payment-schedule for SME's struggling with economic viability ( in case no pre-payment)



#### **PPFA**

- Money collected by Aministrator on behalf of NEW-IG and N.ERGHY (Acting Administrator: NEW-IG Secretariat)
- Contribution held on a separate and dedicated account for this purpose (PPFA)
- Contribution only released to fund running cost of the PO
- Administrator serves as a collecting-office to transfer the money, so no services/VAT involved



# **FAQ**

Is the project-contribution an eligible cost?

No – the project contribution cannot be seen as a cost in the project

Will I receive my full grant?

Yes – All beneficiaries receive the full grant. By setting the payment of the contribution of against the release of the prepayment of the grant, two payments are made within one single transaction

 Why can the Programme – office not just deduct this amount from the outset?

The project contribution is not part of the grant
