 - Report under preparation










Sector Forum Energy Management Working Group Hydrogen

- Objective to provide gap analysis on main research and standardisation barriers for use of hydrogen in the energy system.
- 80+ experts from more than 60 European companies and organisations
- JRC co-convener from 2015 2019.
- Roadmap of key near term actions
- JRC role in CEN/CENELEC JTC 6, founded on recommendation of first SFEM WG H2 report
- Outcome used on follow-up standardisation activities and for RCS SCG

Phase 2 [2017 – 2020]: focussing on HDV and buses, vehicle receptacle, on-board storage tests, Fire tests, material compatibility.


The results of several FCH2JU PNR projects contribute to Phase 2

Single Cell Testing Hardware JRC ZEROVCELL



- Final JRC ZERO∇CELL single cell test hardware with 10 cm² active area
- For use in MEA testing by partners of FCH 2 JU funded projects following NDA signature
- Blueprints (drawings) shared with IDFAST project partners (CEA, POLIMI, DLR, Fh-ISE, ZSW) following NDA signature
- Possible interest expressed by IRD, CIEMAT, TU
 Chemnitz, CNRS, PSI, TU Graz, Univ. Birmingham,
 VTT, SINTEF, JMFC, NedStack





Testing protocols

- Low-temperature water electrolysis (LTWE) testing protocols harmonisation – final report soon to be sent to expert group
- High temperature electrolysis (HTE) terminology document expert group decided on work programme for 2020 with first draft in Q1 and final report in Q4
- Outcome will be utilised for standardisation activities (IEC and ISO)


- Based on LCA report 2018, workshop held 24th of June 2019.


