HAVING REGARD to Articles 86(4) and 88(1) of FCH Financial Rules,

HAVING REGARD to Article 147(3) of Commission Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 2342/2002 of 23 December 2002 laying down detailed rules for the implementation of the Financial Regulation (hereafter referred to as “the Implementing Rules”), as last amended by Commission Regulation (EC, Euratom) No 478/2007 of 23 April 2007 (Implementing Rules of the Financial Regulation),
