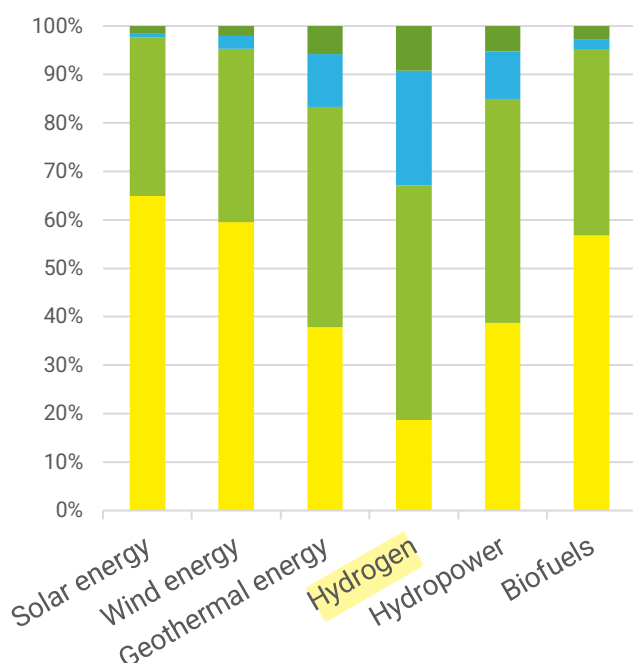

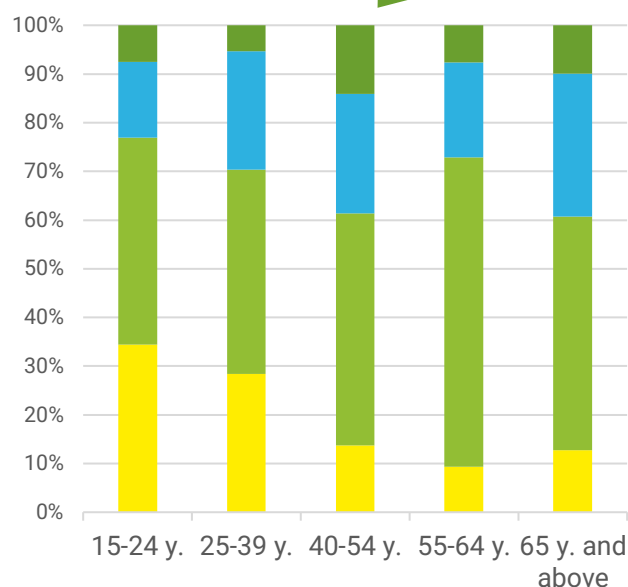
AWARENESS OF ENERGY AND HYDROGEN

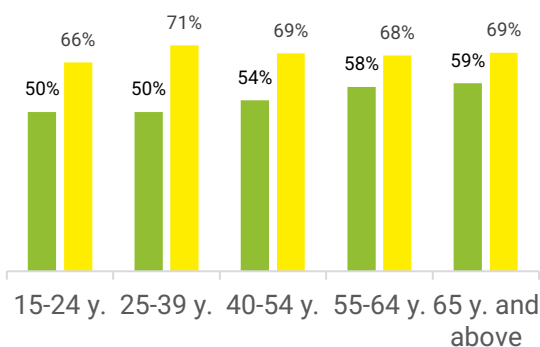

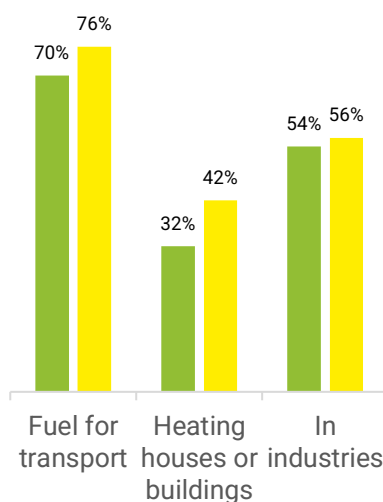

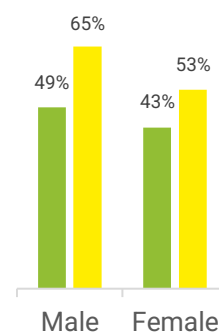

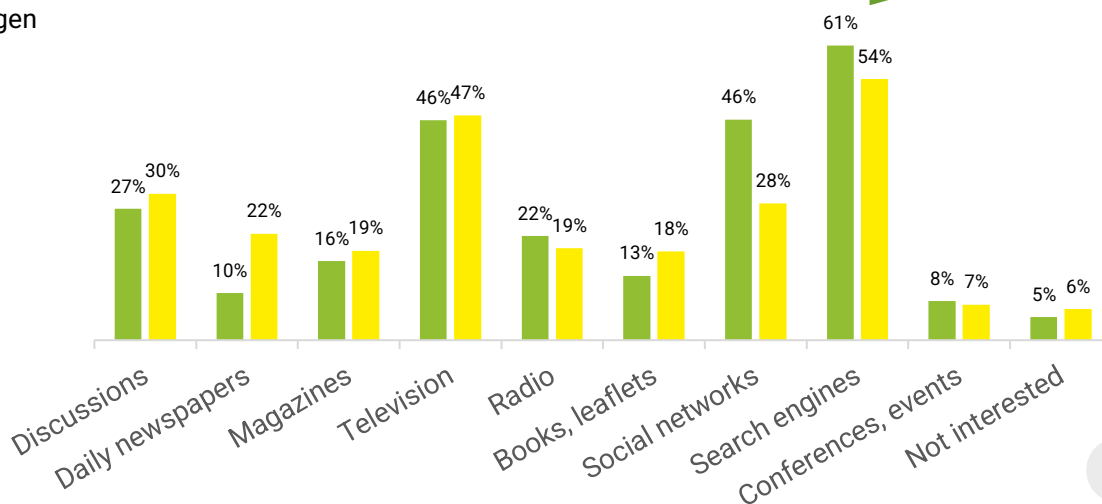

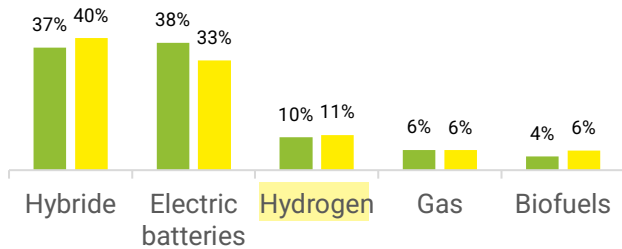

When you look for information on energy in general, which of the following sources, if any, do you use?

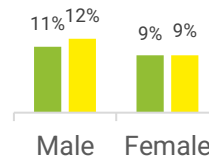

If you were to switch to a new car using an alternative energy, what would you choose?

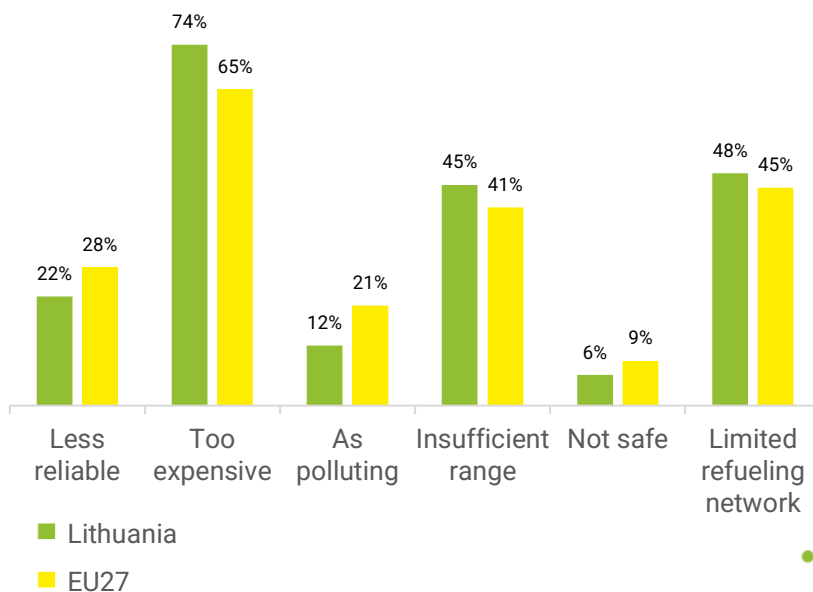


If you were to switch to a new car using an alternative energy, would you choose Hydrogen ?
